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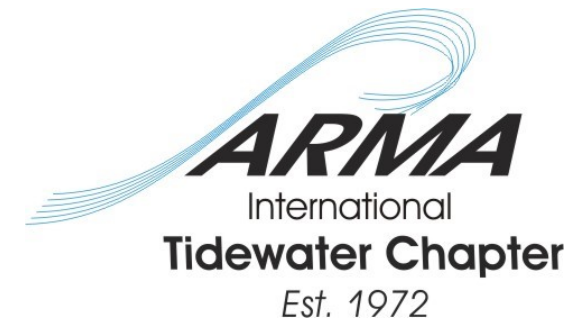
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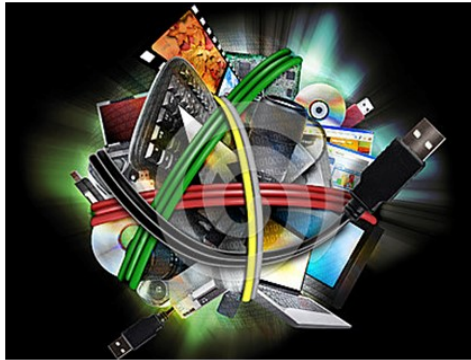
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More About the Tidewater Chapter of ARMA

What is ARMA? ARMA, the Information Governance Professionals, is a professional organization and is open to anyone involved in managing records and information.

What does the Tidewater Chapter do? Our Chapter works to promote and organize records management initiatives in this area. The Chapter holds monthly meetings to help instruct, inform, and provide networking opportunities to business and government records professionals.

What geographic area does your Chapter cover? Chesapeake, Gloucester, Hampton, Isle of Wight County, Newport News, Norfolk, Poquoson, Portsmouth, Smithfield, Suffolk, Virginia Beach, Williamsburg, York County, Eastern Shore of VA & NE North Carolina.

Where and when do you meet? At this time, meetings are held on the third Tuesday of each month at locations on the Southside & Peninsula. Meeting locations, times, and RSVP information are listed in our Chapter newsletter, Tidal Waves, and on our website.

Do you hold any special meetings throughout the year? The Chapter holds a Seminar each spring to offer training in records and information governance principles. Additionally, we hold a joint meeting each fall with the Richmond ARMA Chapter and a Bosses'
